Organics Recycling Reminder

Mandatory recycling of organic waste is the next step to achieving California's Zero Waste goals and together we can be a part of the solution. In addition to food scraps and landscape waste, food-soiled cardboard and paper products are also acceptable to place into your green organics cart. Paper bags, paper napkins, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, paper and cardboard takeout containers and takeout boxes (with no plastic or wax coating, and with all metal removed), coffee filters, soiled pizza boxes, tissues and newspaper are all paper products that can be used to wrap or hold your food scraps in before placing them in your green organics cart.



Please do not use any kind of plastic bags (including certified compostable or biodegradable bags) for any type of green waste, food waste or other organics collection or disposal, as they contaminate the compost! Also, please do not put rocks, dirt or pet waste in the green cart.

Christmas Tree Recycling

Please place botanical decorations *inside your green organics cart* on your collection day and follow these guidelines when setting out your Christmas tree for curbside collection on your regular collection day, December 26, 2022 - January 6, 2023:

- Remove all lights, ornaments, tinsel and the tree stand
- Cut tree in 4-foot lengths and trim off branches
- Place trimmed tree ***inside your green organics cart with the lid closed***
- No flocked trees please

The Bulky Pickup Program will be suspended during the tree recycling program and will return on Jan. 9th.

Holiday Recycling

As the holidays draw closer each day, knowing the most environmentally beneficial ways to dispose of everyday holiday products such as wrapping paper, cardboard, and soiled-paper products is essential. When not disposed of correctly or just thrown in the trash, these standard holiday items can pollute the environment and increase waste in landfills.

Recycle These Items in your Blue Recycling Cart:



Wrapping paper (no metallic paper), cardboard and paper gift boxes (reuse when possible), glass bottles, hard plastic bottles, cartons, pie tins, and greeting cards (paper only).

Recycle These Items in your Green Organics Cart:



Poinsettia's, Christmas trees, pumpkins, turkey bones, fruit cake, food scraps, soiled-paper products such as paper bags, paper napkins, paper towels, paper plates, paper cups, paper and cardboard takeout containers and takeout boxes (with no plastic or wax coating, and with any metal removed), coffee filters, and tissues.

Place These Items in your Grey Trash Cart:



Foil wrapping, foil bows and ribbons, broken ornaments, and Styrofoam peanuts.
